Tidal Tar Zapper will effectively expel gum, tar, and organic stains from tree sap or berries from these surfaces. It can also safely be used on brick, metal, stone, and vinyl surfaces.

Applications:

- Tidal Tar Zapper is a liquid detergent that can be used to eliminate gum, tar, and organic stains from concrete, brick, metal, stone, and vinyl surfaces.
- For gum: Spray Tidal Tar Zapper onto gum, let sit for 5 minutes, then scrape off with a putty knife or rinse with a power washer. Repeat if needed.
- For tar: Spray Tidal Tar Zapper onto tar, let sit for 15-30 minutes (apply more solution if it begins to dry), then rinse off with a power washer. Repeat if needed.
- For organic stains (tree sap, berries, oil stains): Spray Tidal Tar Zapper onto stain, let sit for a short period of time, then scrub with a scrub brush and rinse with a power washer.
- For minor stains, Tidal Tar Zapper may be diluted before use.
- Always rinse surfaces well after using Tidal Tar Zapper.
- Do not use Tidal Tar Zapper on asphalt, rubber, fabric, or delicate paints.
